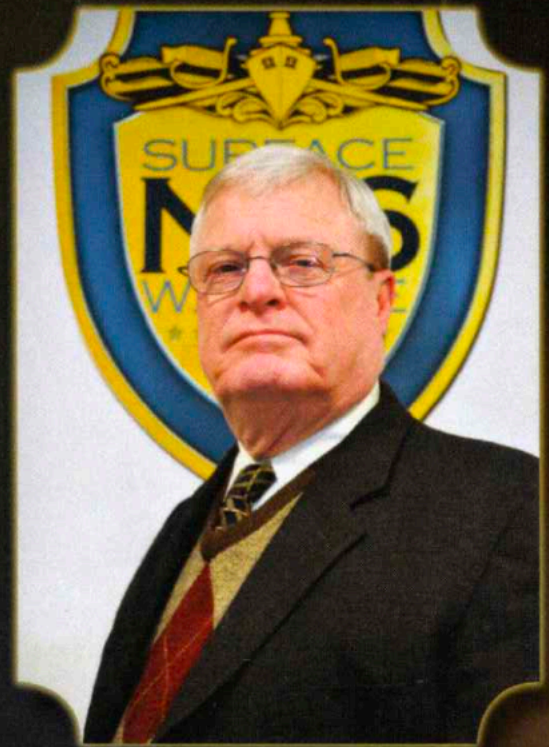


WILLIAM DOUD



William "Bill" Doud was born in Washington, D.C., on August 22, 1948. The son of a career Air Force Officer, he graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy with the class of 1970 and served for the next thirty years as a Surface Warfare Officer. His active duty assignments included service in seven ships, several afloat staffs, and in a variety of assignments ashore. Navy career highlights included command of USS ANTIETAM (CG 54), USS MAHAN (DDG 42), and as Chief of Staff at Commander, Naval Surface Forces Pacific and United States Second Fleet. Bill also served as the Director of Surface Warfare Officer distribution (PERS 41), as a Battle Watch Captain during OPERATION DESERT STORM, and he was one of the initial officers assigned to Navy BMD when that directorate was established on the CNO's staff in 1994.

Upon his retirement from Navy active service in 2000, Bill went to work in support of the Navy as a defense consultant in the then new mission area of Ballistic Missile Defense. Since that time, he has served in DASN (TCS), ACNO (MD), N71, N76, N86, and N96. His principal role has been as a BMD subject matter expert and special assistant to all of the Flag Officers and Captains who have had the BMD portfolio on the CNO's staff from August 2000 until the present time.

Bill is married to the former Valeria "Katie" Fuller of Bethesda, Maryland and they reside in Centreville, Virginia. The Douds have three grown children and three grandchildren.
