Mr. Scott Perry is the Director for Strategic Plans, Communication & Alignment and also the Director for Business Operations at the Aegis Ballistic Missile Defense (BMD) Program Directorate,

located in Dahlgren, Virginia. He is the principal advisor to the Program Director, Aegis BMD on issues related to defining and upholding the mission and vision of the Aegis BMD program. Mr. Perry has also served as Chief of Staff and Acting Director for Personnel Management and as the Special Assistant to the Missile Defense Agency's first Technical Director. He was awarded the Secretary of Defense Medal for Exceptional Civilian Service for his work associated with Operation Burnt Frost in 2008.

Mr. Perry's involvement in Navy Ballistic Missile Defense began in late 1991. During this period, he executed the first Navy BMD tests and led the selection of the Pacific Missile Range Facility (PMRF) Kauai Test Facility (KTF) as the primary Navy BMD test range. In 1996, he was selected as the first Project Engineer for the Navy Theater Wide Theater Ballistic Missile Defense Program. In recognition of his expertise, Mr. Perry was selected in 1999 to lead the Congressionally mandated joint Navy-Ballistic Missile Defense Organization Naval National Missile Defense Concept Definition Study. While in the field, Mr. Perry concentrated on Targets and Threat Simulation. He also assisted in modeling the F18 flight control system and in conducting structural testing of advanced air vehicle systems.

Mr. Perry earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Aerospace and Ocean Engineering at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (Virginia Tech). He is a certified "Range Rat" and qualified drone pilot. Mr. Perry, his wife Juliane (Julie), and daughter Hayley reside in Fredericksburg, Virginia. Their son, LCpl Matthew Perry (USMC) is stationed at 29 Palms, CA, and deploys to Afghanistan this winter.
